In about 10 days, Paige and I will be embarking on yet another "Great Adventure" with the youth and young adults of our church community. For the 12 of us going, this year's trip to Denver will certainly prove to be a challenge in both heart and spirit. Naturally, we solicit your ongoing prayers and encouragement. Working with the homeless in any major city is a heavy task, but one which we believe God has called us to and will certainly equip us for.

Over the last 3 years, our church family has been extremely loving, supportive, and encouraging to our group of young missionaries. We have been greatly humbled by both your attendance and your donations at our fund raisers. We have been greatly blessed by your daily notes of encouragement and sugar-coated treats! And, we have been deeply touched by your love and support. For all that you have done, thank you!

Once again, we would like to invite you to further your support and generosity by helping us with a couple of needs. You may remember that each year we offer a program called "Adopt a Missionary." Our invitation is that each of you prayerfully consider which member of our mission team that you would like to adopt/support. We ask that for each day of our trip (6 days total), that you write a brief letter or note of prayerful encouragement, coupled with a small treat or item of encouragement (candy, pictures, jokes, etc.). We ask that you place each days note/gift in a Ziploc bag so that they are easy to keep separate and label them with the missionary's name. I will tell you from experience that our kids have always been deeply blessed by your words, your prayers, and your thoughtfulness. Thank you!

We would also like to invite you to share in our trip by making a small food donation to assist our travels. There will be a list of needed items printed in this Sunday's bulletin (June 30<sup>th</sup>). I know that we are in need of chips, bread, sliced cheese, ketchup, mustard, and Gatorade, just to name a few items. If you would like to help us in this capacity, we will need all donated items to be brought to the church by Friday, July 5<sup>th</sup>.

# YOUTH MISSION TRIP TO DENVER

On July 6, 2019, twelve individuals will be traveling to Denver, Colorado for a week to work with Open Door Ministries in their many programs to homeless and low income families. Please pray for these kids and adults as they prepare to go and while they are there. They are: **Andrew Boyer, Noah Christensen, Hannah Herrman, Abigail Boyer, Jordan Boyer, Nathan Johnson, Jacob Johnson, Christopher Gillman, Gavin Bussert, Deron Boyer, Paige Boyer, and Jan Rathburn.**



Open Door ministries was started in 1997 as an extension of Open Door Fellowship Church to minister to the homeless and low income families in the Denver area. It has grown to include 18 different

programs to provide food, shelter, access to education and employment training, friendship, hope, and Christian guidance. These programs are:

- Open Door to Success – employment training program
- Street2Life Print Shop – business offering transitional employment to people on the street
- Three homes for single women suffering from homelessness, addictions and abuse:  
Chayah House, Esther House, Treasure House
- Cornerstone Home – home for disabled men
- Te Veo House – short term housing for women in crisis
- Lighthouse – home for single men dealing with addictions and homelessness
- Sanctuary Housing – short term housing for those in hardship or homeless
- Nehemiah Leadership Hall – housing and training for emerging urban leaders
- The Table – meal served Saturdays and Sundays
- TRYAD – Reaches disabled individuals/evangelism
- Urban Immersion – organizes short term trips
- The Family Room – provides hospitable place to rest
- Ezra – outreach/mentoring ministry to homeless
- The Learning Center – education for kids 3yrs – 12yrs
- Downtown Youth Center – Bible studies/activities for urban youth
- Westside Youth Center – Discipleship/tutoring for youth

# NEW MISSION: Chinese to Christ Ministries (C2C)

Last September, the Mission department decided to add, Chinese to Christ Ministries (C2C) to the missions supported by Countryside Church. In April, Wing Wong came to the Faith Promise rally and presented his mission work in New Hampshire and also in China. Wing Wong has worked for many years in China presenting the message of Christ and also to the Chinese in New Hampshire. The work in New Hampshire is under the partnership of Restoration House Ministries.

## We Pray:

*Pray for Wing Wong as he brings the message of Jesus Christ to the Chinese people in New Hampshire and in China.*

"I want to take the time to sincerely thank you for your prayers and financial support to C2C. May the Lord continue to bless you as well as our brothers and sisters in China.

China's crackdown on Christians and their churches is intensifying. The new restrictions on internet, social media and religion are all seriously limiting freedom. Christian persecution happens countryside in both state-approved and non-registered churches. Before, churches were perceived as a threat if they became too large or too political. Today even small family churches are at risk. The youth are increasingly being removed from church life, worship is monitored via CCTV and spies, civil servants are told not to have any religious affiliation. The so called 'Qing Ling Movement' (literally it means empty out to zero) is aiming to reset Christianity in the country. The Chinese government simply wants to completely destroy all family churches. Our brothers and sisters are no longer allowed to rent any property for religious activities. Under all of these new regulations, many Christians were arrested in the past few months. They will be remaining in jail until their court day. Please pray that God will give strength to our brothers and sisters who are in detention.

Our Heavenly Father is our shield and will be with us in the valley and on the mountaintops."

## DID YOU KNOW?

2018 was the start of a 5 year government plan in China to sinicize Christianity. The government's ultimate objective for this plan is to sanitize Christianity in order to better reflect Chinese socialist views and culture. Religions can operate only if they are "Chinese in orientation" and Beijing "must provide active guidance to religions so that they can adapt themselves to socialist society".

Bible have started disappearing from online stores including Taobao and Jingdong. Where, searching for key words for Bible came up with "no results", or if it was found people could not add it into their carts. A major speculation from the online community about why Bibles have been removed from the stores was that it is in preparation for the eventual release of the state-sanctioned version of the Bible.

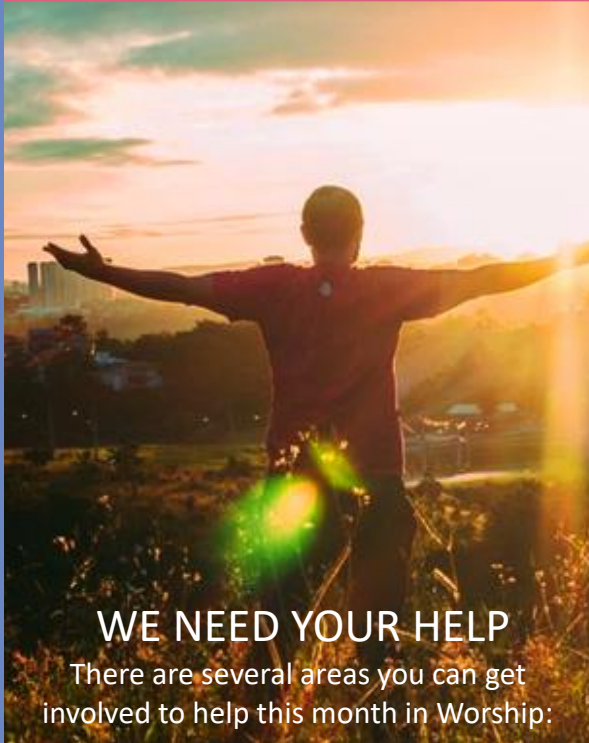

## PATRIOTIC PINWHEEL

Create this colorful July 4<sup>th</sup> craft.

### What you need:

- Decorated card stock square (5" x 5")
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- 2 one-inch circles of card stock
- Glue
- Pipe cleaner (3 inches)
- Drinking straw



### What you do:

1. Fold the square corner to corner to form an X. Unfold.
2. To make spokes, cut the four creases until an inch from the center.
3. Punch a hole in the middle of the square, near the tips of each spoke, and in the middle of each circle.
4. Fold each spoke toward the center, lining up the holes. Glue in place.
5. Wrap one end of the pipe cleaner around the top of the straw. Thread a circle, the pinwheel, and the remaining circle onto the pipe cleaner.
6. Roll the pipe cleaner end into a ball. Then spin!

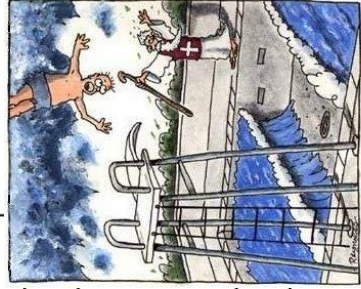
