



We will be watching videos our missionaries have sent with updates of what they are doing. We will also be collecting our faith promises for the coming year during the worship service that Sunday.

MISSION HIGHLIGHT: Rock River Christian Camp

Rock River Christian Camp is located near Polo, Illinois. It is our Christian camp outreach and is supported by about 30 Christian churches in the WI, IL, and IA area.

Because of the COVID virus, this camping summer has been very different. This summer has been very quiet with all summer programs canceled. The staff has been working very hard at keeping expenses down, the pool remains closed, no large food orders, keeping electrical to a minimum and not summer staff salaries. They are maintaining the grounds and working on small projects that do not cost much if anything. They are sending out this mailing to give everyone an update on what is happening at Rock River Christian Camp.

Phase 4 for the State of Illinois states, "no overnight camps allowed" so no retreats. Phase 4 will last until a vaccine is available so no camps in the foreseeable future. As a camp staff and camp board they will continue to talk through options as well as what they plan to do in the future if nothing changes.

This is a hard year for RRCC as it impacts the financial state of the camp significantly. They have made a profit and loss comparison From January to June this year compared to last year and find the camp down \$112,102. This is the loss of a lot of money and the camp needs our help. If RRCC has impacted your life and you would like to see it continue to impact lives for future generations, then do your part today and give.


BOOKS

- Cardboard scrap
- Acrylic paints (2 colors)
- 2 small paper plates
- Apple

- Foam brush
- Scrap paper

What you do:



- Pour a paint dollop on each plate.
- Slice the apple in half, keeping the core intact.
- Brush a thin layer of paint on the cut side of an apple half. Practice making stamps on scrap paper. Use the other color on the other apple half.
- Paint and stamp the bag with your final design. When dry, remove the cardboard.
