MISSION HIGHLIGHT: I.D.E.S.

IDES stands for International Disaster Emergency Service. IDES exists to bring glory to God by meeting physical and spiritual needs in our hurting world until Jesus returns. For the past 47 years IDES has served as a channel through which Christian Churches/Churches of Christ and individual Christians could meet the physical and spiritual needs of suffering people throughout the world. The vision statement: "IDES vision is to lead the independent Christian Churches/Churches of Christ in responding to disasters and emergencies in the United States and throughout the world by mobilizing financial and physical resources to and through their missionaries and congregations for the purpose of benevolent evangelism."

IDES has been the one source our churches and missionaries consistently turn to for help. In 2018, IDES celebrated 45 years of meeting physical and spiritual needs of suffering people throughout the world in the name of Jesus Christ. They have distributed millions of dollars over the years to help with disaster relief, development projects, medical needs, evangelism and hunger. Among independent Christian Churches/Churches of Christ, the work of IDES is unique.

"Many recognize that a white flag displayed on the battlefield means 'cease fire'. A request from one of the IDES' mission partners in Guatemala, points up a more recent meaning for the white flag. Many of the assistance requests IDES is receiving each week are related to the COVID-19 pandemic. This has been the case since March, and will likely continue for some time. Often these requests relate to medical needs, but an even larger number are focused on hunger relief.

Thus in Guatemala, white flags flown at the doorway have become a symbol, not of surrender, but of desperation. They are a cry for help. They indicate a home is without food, and its occupants urgently need assistance. IDES' mission partner in one Guatemalan village is Brother Joshua. He ministers to a congregation consisting of about 30 households. On the street where he lives, Brother Joshua recently counted 5 white flags. IDES is partnering with Brother Joshua's mission to feed the families in his church, and many more in the community around them (about 600 people total) for the next 6 weeks.



Through June, IDES has worked with 64 partners in 33 countries and 8 U.S. states to bring COVID-19 relief to hundreds of hard-hit communities like Brother Joshua's." (Newsletter of July 31, 2020)



Currently, Countryside Christian Church is planning a food bag packing event on Oct. 2,2021. We will be working with the Erie Christian Church for this event. Details will be forth coming.

As you can see IDES is a very busy, global organization meeting a variety of physical and spiritual needs. For more information about their activities check the mission booklet on the mission table in the foyer.


