What is this world coming to?

The paragraph above has in fact been lived out by thousands of Christians. We read about it in the New Testament. In Acts we see the government of Rome prompted by the Jews to squash efforts of a growing Christian church. Arresting, imprisoning, beating, and persecuting Christians was a daily event under later Roman rulers. For a Christian to publicly claim Christ as Savior was a willing choice to die for their faith. Mobs of people would gather together to laugh, drink, and party as Christians were burned at the stake or fed to lions. All of this is a part of a well-documented experience for the early Christian church.

There is another fact that is well-documented. There is no written record of any Christian in the first century church asking the question... What is this world coming to? However there are hundreds of documents recording hundreds of Christians boldly declaring... Look who has come into this world. Christ the Savior of the world has come to this world to redeem the sinner, rescue the lost, and give hope to the hopeless. Jesus taught that this world in not our home, our hope, or our future.

Today, If you find yourself asking the question what is this world coming to...

STOP and reflect on who has come to this world. Jesus stands at the door of your heart and wants you to let Him in. Jesus says "Come to me and I will give you rest." 

MISSION HIGHLIGHT: Christ to China Ministry-C2C

In September 2018 the Mission department decided to add, Christ to China, (C2C) to the missions supported by Countryside. In April, 2018 Wing Wong came to the Faith/Promise rally and presented his mission work C2C, in New Hampshire and also in China. Wing Wong has worked over 50 years in China presenting the message of Christ to the people and also to the Chinese in New Hampshire. The work in New Hampshire is under the partnership of Restoration House Ministries.



"Most of you will agree with me that this was one of the most challenging years. It started out with our China coworkers being detained, questioned and threatened by Chinese officials for holding religious activities. The police also confiscated hundreds of our New Approach thumb drives. Soon after that, the pandemic broke out in Wuhan China and spread around the world. This had messed up our whole year of planning and schedules. However we know

that "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are God's ways higher than our ways and God's thoughts than our thoughts." (Isaiah 55:9) (2020 Christmas newsletter)

In September Wing contracted the virus and ended up in ICU for 6 days. He said that the recovery process was long and challenging and he thought he might never be well but after 2 months he felt 90% recovered.

Last year a young boy, 13 years old, named Moses was diagnosed with Ewing Sarcoma and given a 20% chance of survival. He is now doing well having his last month of chemotherapy. During the course of fighting the disease he and his mother have accepted Jesus into their lives and were baptized in the name of Christ.

Many young people are being brainwashed into the communist philosophy and atheism and rejecting Christianity. Spreading the Gospel message is becoming more and more of a challenge.

The pandemic hit many people financially. C2C income dropped 32% and a 19% decrease in the number of supporting churches and 27% decrease in the number of individual supporters. At the same time the expenses increased 18%. However, God is good and the PPP government loan helped make ends meet. They were only a little short when they closed the books for 2020, but it was covered by the surplus we had in 2019. Praise the Lord!

Wing Wong is in his 51st year of service to our Lord. For more information about the work in China and the Chinese people in New Hampshire check the C2C booklet on the mission shelf.







What you do:


- 1. Pour about 3 cups of boiling water into a bowl. Soak sticks in the water about 30 minutes.




