Many people have expressed their appreciation of the Kids Club program to me; and I am very happy with the Kids Club program at Countryside. Moreover, it is very important that you hear how it got started. (And for the record I had very little to do with any of it). This is the list of people to thank...

One day last summer (2020) Laura left the office to go to lunch, and 20 seconds later she texted me and said there is a lady and her kids in the parking lot and you should go talk to them. So I did. I met Naomi Jones and her kids learning to ride their bikes on a wide open parking lot. I learned she is related to Kathy Kohrt.

Fast forward to last fall when school was getting started and we learned that there would be no school on Wednesdays. I thought if I had school-aged kids, this would be a hardship, and I thought this could be an opportunity to serve the Riverdale community with some tutoring at the church. It would also be a way to meet families with kids. So I asked Laura to send out an email to the church to see if there would be anyone interested in helping tutor kids for an hour on Wednesdays. Many people replied and we had a meeting at church to discuss how such a program might work. I led the meeting, thinking we could tutor kids for an hour and send them home, but Becki Winger said we should have the kids from 7-11am and have a full kids program. I thought to myself but did not say out loud... "that's too much". However, the idea caught on and plans were made. Again, Laura sent out an email for willing workers and many agreed. Wayne and Cathy Lotz, Sandy and Rock Lawrence, Kathy Kohrt, Becki Winger, Teresa Garcia, Roger and Connie Curry, Sarah Denekas, Laura's family, Criss Evans, and Bob Gipson all agreed to help. Many more helpers were added later!

I am so grateful that God has placed me in a church with so many willing workers that give up their Wednesday mornings week after week after week. Please praise the Lord for His provision and please tell all the willing workers thank you for all the time they have put in to make Kids Club great. Now you know what you need to know about Kids Club.

One more thing... Please pray that the families that are connected to Kids Club will find their way to Jesus. Then we will know that Kids Club is truly great!

MISSION HIGHLIGHT: Local Food Pantry



The Upper Rock Island County food pantry is located in Messiah Lutheran Church in Port Byron. Countryside supports this pantry with monthly food donations.

Things which are needed by the pantry include

- non-perishable food items
- cleaning items (dish soap, laundry soap, bar soap),
- paper products (paper towels toilet tissue, facial tissue)
- personal hygiene products (tooth brushes, tooth paste, deodorant, feminine hygiene products)
- baby items including diapers and baby food.

Many of those items cannot be purchased with food stamps so the food pantry tries to fill these items. These lists are not inclusive.


The food pantry is for residents of the Riverdale School District and is open 12 noon to 2 p.m. each Wednesday. Due to the Corona Virus items will be pre packed and delivered to your vehicle in a drive thru at the church parking lot. The food pantry can be reached at 309-523-2421 if there are questions.

Countryside items are delivered to the pantry the last week of each month. Food pantry items remain in great need all year round. School will be out in mid -June so family food needs will be greater when children are home full time. With the current pandemic the needs within our community are even greater. The pantry also accepts cash donations and then purchases items that are needed. Please leave the pantry donations in the marked boxes in the Countryside foyer.


