From Steve's Desk ...

Dear Countryside Church family,

I can't believe it's September. Because of Covid 19, I feel as though I started working at Countryside in March of 2020, doing some in person and many video sermons. A year and a half with Countryside has been such a blessing. When I think back to the first time that I ever walked in the building (Don and Donna Vickroy gave me a tour) and all of the changes that have been made to it since then, it's just amazing.

Think for a moment about these changes... The lobby was filled with original church pews, the communion table was at the front center of the stage, the choir loft wall projected across the front of the stage, the little preaching platform that I stand on did not exist. All of those changes were made to accommodate our indoor services after being outside for COVID. Then we started Kids Club and Construction Club which led to the remodeling of the lower lobby with the decorative wall that says "Welcome Home" and the replaced floor. We made our way up into the hall, changing the carpet, adding brighter lights, bulletin boards, and windows in the doors of the classrooms. And now the entryway in the main lobby has been opened up and new carpet is going in. That is a lot of transformation! That is a lot of change.

I often refer to the church building as a tool. It's good to have a good sharp tool to get the work done. But the church building is only a tool. A better question we should all ask ourselves is... in the last 18 months, has there been any change in your heart? We meet together for Sunday morning Worship, Tuesday morning Bible study, Wednesday evening Bible study, and Sunday School has started again. These are all designed to sharpen us spiritually. It's easy to look down the hall and see new carpet. Sometimes, personally, it's more difficult to look inside down the hallways of our heart and ask is anything new?

Please allow the changes to the building to be an example or even a motivation to rework the interior of your soul. Spend time in prayer, spend time reading your Bible, spend time reaching out, calling your church family, and being involved with one another's lives. Become more like Jesus in all that you do... be transformed by the renewing of your mind. (Romans 12:2)




EVANGELISM HIGHLIGH



"For I was hungry, and you gave me something to eat..." - Matthew 25:35

On Saturday October 2nd, Countryside will partner with the Erie Christian Church in preparing food bags for IDES (International Disaster Emergency Services). The set up and unloading of the truck will occur at 8:00 A.M. At 9:00A.M. we will begin filling the bags and work until finished filling the bags (4-5 hours). During the set-up we will need approximately 10 people who can lift boxes, move tables and take directions for set up and for being a crew leader. Each crew of 10 will need a leader who can give the crew instructions and oversee their line in bag filling. We are hoping to have six crews, three from Erie, and three from CCC. Thirty-five people from CCC will be needed to be crew members and will require extended periods of standing. We plan to be finished by early afternoon - that will be determined by the number of workers. Snacks and water will be provided. A sign up list is in the church lobby. Even if you can only work for a short period of time, sign up as workers will need rest periods.

IDES provides nutritious meals which are sent to countries that have experienced disasters. Each bag contains the equivalent of 6 meals which can be reconstituted with water. Each meal contains vitamins, minerals and rice. In Sept. of 2018 we prepared 4000 bags or 24000 meals. If you have any questions please see Connie Curry.

knows it very well. (Ps 139:14)


Impact Design

MISSION HIGHLIGHT: C2C Ministry

In September 2018 the Mission department decided to add, Christ to China, (C2C) to the missions supported by Countryside. In April, 2018 Wing Wong came to the Faith/Promise rally and presented his mission work C2C, in New Hampshire and also in China. Wing Wong has worked over 50 years in China presenting the message of Christ to the people and also to the Chinese in New Hampshire. The work in New Hampshire is under the partnership of Restoration House Ministries.





"Since our last communication, many things have happened in our ministries. Although the government in China has been working hard to close the doors and windows for true Christianity, the Lord continues to give us new opportunities and prospects. Last week, two church groups met for four days. The people were so hungry for the word, they met from 6:00a.m.- 10:00p.m. everyday. At the closing of the conference, three were baptized into Christ. Thank God for opening doors although Satan tries hard to fan us off through the communist authority and policy. Pray that God will bless our team to bless the lost and bring them to Christ. Pray for those who want to accept Christ will be baptized into Him soon. Pray for more workers for the harvest." (July 2021 Newsletter)

"Let me start with praise and joy! In the last few weeks our Chinese teams have baptized three in one city, nine in another and last Sunday twenty-one in a beautiful river in China. God is good! Despite the Chinese government's continued efforts in tightening up the screws for religion, the Lord continues to open doors and lead more people into His folds. Please pray for these new babies in Christ that they will get the proper spiritual nourishment and guidance so they may grow to the full measure of Christ." (Newsletter Aug. 12, 2021)

Many young people are being brainwashed into the communist philosophy of atheism and rejecting Christianity. Spreading the Gospel message is becoming more and more of a challenge.

The pandemic hit many people financially. C2C income dropped 32% and a 19% decrease in the number of supporting churches and 27% decrease in the number of individual supporters. At the same time the expenses increased 18%. However, God is good and the PPP government loan helped make ends meet. They were only a little short when they closed the books for 2020, but it was covered by the surplus we had in 2019. Praise the Lord!

Wing Wong is in his 51st year of service to our Lord. For more information about the work in China and the Chinese people in New Hampshire check the C2C booklet on the mission shelf.

"What will the next generation of Christians in China be like if we sit back and take the easy road? Will God be pleased? Thank you for laboring with us in prayers and supports!"

Paul urged his readers to make giving a natural and regular part of their Christian walk. He saw it as a way for believers to care for each other and to stay unified in purpose. Not only that, Paul understood the importance righteous giving has on a Christian's future. The teachings of Jesus, such as this one from Luke, were never far from his thoughts:

'Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has been pleased to give you the kingdom. Sell your possessions and give to the poor. Provide purses for yourselves that will not wear out, a treasure in heaven that will never fail, where no thief comes near and no moth destroys. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.' (Luke 12:32-34)

Paul wanted his readers to see Jesus' motivations for giving:

- •His love for God and for us
- •His compassion for our needs
- •His desire to share what He has

The Apostle hoped that by seeing this model, believers would feel inspired as he did to look at giving not as a burden, but an opportunity to become more Christlike. Paul's letters modeled what it looks like to "live to give."


