Christmas is the introduction of Jesus...

Luke 2:1-16

In those days Caesar Augustus issued a decree that a census should be taken of the entire Roman world. This was the first census that took place while Quirinius was governor of Syria.) And everyone went to their own town to register.

So Joseph also went up from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to Bethlehem the town of David, because he belonged to the house and line of David. He went there to register with Mary, who was pledged to be married to him and was expecting a child. While they were there, the time came for the baby to be born, and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger, because there was no guest room available for them.

And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, keeping watch over their flocks at night. An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord. This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger."

Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying, "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests." When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let's go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about." So they hurried off and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby, who was lying in the manger.

As a child, Christmas was all about getting the presents. I can remember not being able to sleep. Waking up sooo early in the morning and my parents wanting me to go back to bed, yet they saw my excitement and got up because they love me (and probably my sister too?). These are great memories of Christmas for me. Now I have to ask myself this question. Steve, if Christmas as a child was exciting because you knew you were getting presents... and now you know it's about Jesus... Is Christmas still exciting? Or another question...what about Jesus is as exciting as when you were looking forward to getting presents? I think my best answer to that came when my dad passed away in 2020. The peace and calm that came to me in knowing that my dad loved Jesus, and in an instant went from pain and suffering to the glory of the presence of God. From pain to the presence of Jesus.

The birth of Jesus marked his arrival on earth. My dad's passing marked his arrival in heaven. This truly brings me a joy that I do not fully understand, and it even kind of makes me excited for what he has experienced... and what one day I will experience... an introduction to Jesus.

Impact Life (formerly Mississippi Valley Regional Blood Center) is holding a blood drive at Countryside. The annual blood drive is scheduled for Saturday January 15, 2022. The hours are 7:30-11:30 A.M. To be eligible to donate, you must not have given a blood donation since **November 20, 2021.**

Some blood facts: 38% of the U.S. population is eligible to give blood, but less than 10% actually donate. An adult has approximately 10-12 pints of blood, about 1 in 7 patients require a blood transfusion, more than 4.5 million people need blood transfusions each year, all donated blood is tested for various viruses and diseases before being transfused, including Hepatitis B&C, HIV, HCV, HTLV, Syphilis, West Nile virus and Chagas' disease. Blood donations are used 17% for cancer patients, 11% for General surgery, 8% for heart disease and 8% for trauma.



MISSION HIGHLIGHT: Lincoln Christian University



"Lincoln Bible Institute, 'LBI' was born in the mind and heart of Earl C. Hargrove in 1944 as the result of a God-given vision. From the very beginning unto this very day, countless people have sacrificially provided the resources to carry out this God-given vision of supplying dedicated and well-trained workers for the Kingdom."

Lincoln Christian University (initially Lincoln Bible Institute, then Lincoln Christian College and Seminary, now Lincoln Christian University) was launched on May 4, 1944, to help prepare people to carry out God's effort through the church. For decades, LCU has trained servant leaders to serve the church and world. Mr. Hargrove, LCU's founding president, stated: "We need Kingdom workers." In addition to supplying churches with preachers, LCU has trained worship ministers, youth ministers, church secretaries, Christian education directors, small group leaders, elders, Sunday school teachers, mission committee members and a host of other roles in the church. We are thrilled that God has used so many who took classes at LCU to help build His Church.

For nearly 75 years, LCU has been educating Kingdom-minded leaders to serve in the

church and the world. More than 16,000 have studied there. Hundreds of men and women are currently studying at Lincoln Christian University, learning



how best to communicate the Word of God to this generation and the next.

The Covid virus has impacted the financial situation of LCU in a very dramatic way. Students were being taught virtually and the enrollment declined. They ask for prayers for the finances to improve as the situation returns to more normal this fall of 2021. Classes are being held in person on campus and enrollment is increasing.



In January of 2022 a partnership is being launched with Merold Institute of Harvester Christian Church. Months in the planning and design, this partnership will form a regional training center for church leaders that enhances that work already being done by the Merold Institute by expanding those offerings with fully accredited educational courses and access to Lincoln's placement and church development services. The partnership will be based at Harvester's St. Charles campus. New things continue to be happening at LCU.

Countryside Christian Church offers scholarships to students attending full time at LCU or other Christian Universities. LCU provided interim ministers for us during our time of our preacher search. We are so grateful for this assistance. If you want more information about LCU check the booklet on the mission shelf by the office.


