MISSION HIGHLIGHT: Food Pantry & IDES

Countryside supports our local food pantry located at Messiah Lutheran Church 302 11th Street Port Byron. The food pantry serves residents located in the Riverdale School district. It is open on Wed. from noon until 2:00 P.M. Families are eligible to obtain food once a month.

With summer coming and the kids being out of school, food needs will start being more of an issue for families. Since Christmas, the number of families being served has increased. Some of the specific

needs include all paper products, tooth brushes and toothpaste, soup (not chicken noodle), spaghetti sauce, canned corn, canned pastas, syrup, canned meats, hamburger helper, and of course money.

Grocery prices and other living expenses are increasing for families so money for food items is shrinking. The food pantry recently had a large freezer/ refrigerator donated so food can be stored longer. Non-perishable food items are stored in the pantry space provided by the church. The food pantry is one way for Countryside to support the needs of our local community. 

FAITH Oromise?

The Faith-Promise is different from a tithe. It is not a pledge made to the church; it is a promise made to God. Faith is called for; not faith-to-get, but faith-to-give. You are urged to ask God what you should trust Him for, the amount He will enable you to give during the coming conference year. The basis of the promise is a relationship between you and God. If for any reason you cannot pay your Faith-Promise, the reason should be explained to God. Make your promise, not on the basis of what you HAVE to give, but on the basis of what you believe God will ENABLE you to give.



Last October, we, as a congregation, promised \$37,176 to go toward the expenses of the seven missions we support. Our missionaries are very grateful to Countryside for sharing God's blessings with them. April 24th will be the beginning of the next "Missions Year." We will be collecting our faith promises for the coming year during the worship service that Sunday.

As you remember, April 24th is not just the end of the current Faith Promise year, but it is also our "Mission, Not Impossible" Sunday. - The kitchen has been repainted, a larger freezer will be coming, and cabinets have been cleaned out and re-organized. It looks so nice! Lots of hard work!!






Looking ahead...
