



MISSION HIGHLIGHT: I.D.E.S.


IDES stands for International Disaster Emergency Service. IDES exists to bring glory to God by meeting physical and spiritual needs in our hurting world until Jesus returns. For the past 48 years IDES has served as a channel through which Christian Churches/Churches of Christ and individual Christians could meet the physical and spiritual needs of suffering people throughout the world. The vision statement: "IDES vision is to lead the independent Christian Churches/Churches of Christ in responding to disasters and emergencies in the United States and throughout the world by mobilizing financial and physical resources to and through their missionaries and congregations for the purpose of benevolent evangelism."

IDES has been the one source our churches and missionaries consistently turn to for help. In 2022, IDES celebrates 49 years of meeting physical and spiritual needs of suffering people throughout the world in the name of Jesus Christ. They have distributed millions of dollars over the years to help with disaster relief, development projects, medical needs, evangelism and hunger. Among independent Christian Churches/Churches of Christ, the work of IDES is unique.



During this past year IDES has partnered with CMFI in the Turkana Farms in Kenya, a project of creating irrigated farms. Five irrigated farms have been established to provide a sustainable source of food and income for more than 500 people. Five additional farms are in the process of being built. IDES is currently working in Afghanistan providing aid to displaced persons. In recent years they have provided over \$750,000 of assistance. Since the Taliban takeover on August 15th, things have been even more difficult and this winter the needs are even greater. IDES is committed to providing at least \$250,000 in winter relief for those suffering in Afghanistan, and for the refugees who have fled to surrounding countries. Additionally they are working to secure opportunities to provide help and hope to Afghan refugees here in the United States.





Whenever there is an emergency either man made or by Mother Nature IDES is "the boots on the ground" providing aid and spreading the Gospel message.

As you can see IDES is a very busy, global organization meeting a variety of physical and spiritual needs. For more information about their activities check the mission booklet on the mission table in the foyer.

SEEKING GOD

As I write this, the media is filled with reports of Russia invading Ukraine. As many people rush to evacuate, many pastors and Christians have chosen to stay. Vasyl Ostryi, a pastor at Irpin Bible Church 18 miles northwest of Kyiv and a KTS professor of youth ministry said "When this is over, the citizens of Kyiv will remember how Christians have responded in their time of need. We will shelter the weak, serve the suffering, and mend the broken. And as we do, we offer the unshakable hope of Christ and his gospel."



Photos of Ukrainians kneeling to pray in public are moving even to those who do not believe. The Bible App (YouVersion) has noticed an increase in Russians and Ukranians reading and searching for "peace". The Ukranian Bible Society has almost sold out its entire 2022 stock of Bibles in only the second month of the year. The churches are filled with new people – not just on Saturdays and Sundays – but also through the week. They are desperate for a word of hope.

"Please pray about Russian Christians that they would raise their prayers and voice toward Russian government to stop the aggression; [that they] would not keep silent; please pray for the Western governments, of the US and European Union.

Finally, please pray about Ukrainian Christians, that we will serve and live as the community of hope in a full sense of this term; that during these terrible times we would invite more and more people to the relationships with God and His children, to the relationships of love, hope, encouragement, support; that our minds and characters would continue to transform into the character of Jesus Christ." (Christianity Today, Feb 2022)

Friday, March 4th is the World Day of Prayer. This day is a day that Christians from over 170 different countries come together in spirit, uniting on a common day to pray for relevant issues. The focus is informed prayer and prayerful action.



Won't you join with Christians around the world praying for our brothers and sisters in Christ, not only in Ukraine, but all around the world who face persecution daily? May God's peace reign in the hearts of his children, may many come to believe as they search for hope, and may God's will be done on earth.


