MISSION HIGHLIGHT

MISSION HIGHLIGHT: Pioneer Bible Translators

Norm and Jill state that they are so grateful for our partnership with them in prayer and financial support. For more information refer to the booklet on the mission table in the foyer.

Norm and Jill Weatherhead work with Pioneer Bible Translators in Papua, New Guinea as Bible translators. They have been involved there for over 20+ years. They are from Calgary, Canada. Jill works a portion of the year as a registered nurse in Calgary and joins Norm when she can to work with the translation team in PNG. Drawn by a vision to see God's Work changing lives in every language, Norm and his wife, Jill have devoted their lives to translation work.



Norm has travel plans for the month of June to Illinois. He plans to visit Antioch Christian Church June 19th and then travel to Countryside June 25-26th. He will be meeting with the congregation at 7:00 pm Saturday, June 25th to present his work and then preaching on Sunday morning, June 26th.

With modern technology, Norm is able to continue his translation work from Calgary with the individuals in Papua, New Guinea in spite of the Covid virus. Via Zoom, Norm and the Papua, New Guinea team have been able to complete the checking of the entire book of Mark. God gave Norm the strength to work 4pm (Calgary time) to midnight (4pm PNG time). When he will be able to actually return in person to Papua, New Guinea is not known.

"We asked for your prayers for the translation checking session which we just completed via Zoom, and we completed the goal of checking the entire book of Mark. God oversaw the entire 4 week period and there was only one day where we lost internet connection.

The second major goal we were able to accomplish was to thoroughly check the spelling and meaning of 22 Shellbooks in the Akukem language. Shellbooks are used as a literacy tool to help people to read stories in their own language. There are pictures on the left hand page and the text on the right hand page. The plan is to use these vernacular story books during literacy workshops which will be held in July this year in the two main Akukem villages.

During these July Literacy Fluency Workshops, we hope to have 25 people plus leaders in both villages attend the workshop to help them to learn to read their Akukem language. Remember that before PBT began working with the Akukem people, their language had never been written down, so these literacy workshops will help lay the foundation for them to be able to read the Scriptures when we publish and release the books of Luke and Mark to them." 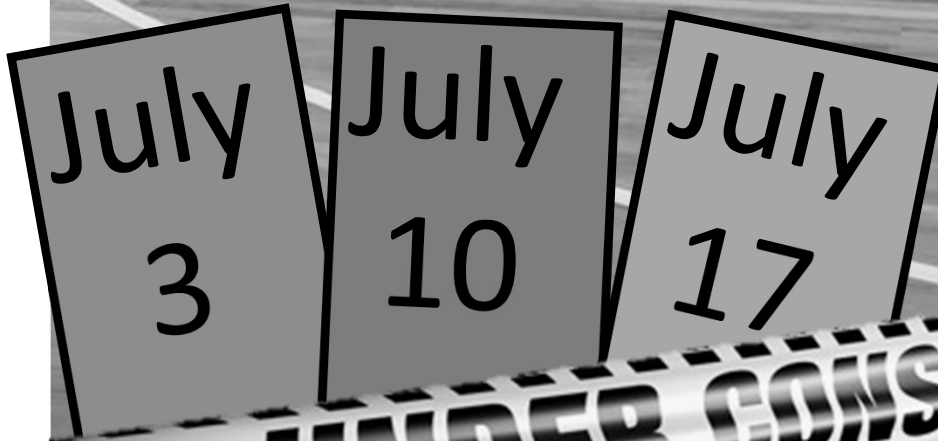
The dedication of the Akukem national translators who have stuck with this translation project for 16 years, for sustaining Norm through these years of pain and fatigue to keep on working on Bible translation, that they were able to complete the checking of the Akukem book of Mark, that they have all the materials ready for the Literacy Fluency Workshops, for the Publishing Department over in Madang which helped to print these 1300+ Shellbooks for the people to have material to learn to read Akukem, for the good internet connection and for the sustained health God gave Norm.

Prayer Requests

That all the final logistics and other details will fall into place for the upcoming July workshops to happen and to run very smoothly, that these workshops will lay the foundation for the Akukem people to be able to read their language and especially the books of Scripture as they become available to them in their language, for safe travels for Norm to Illinois and back during the next few weeks.

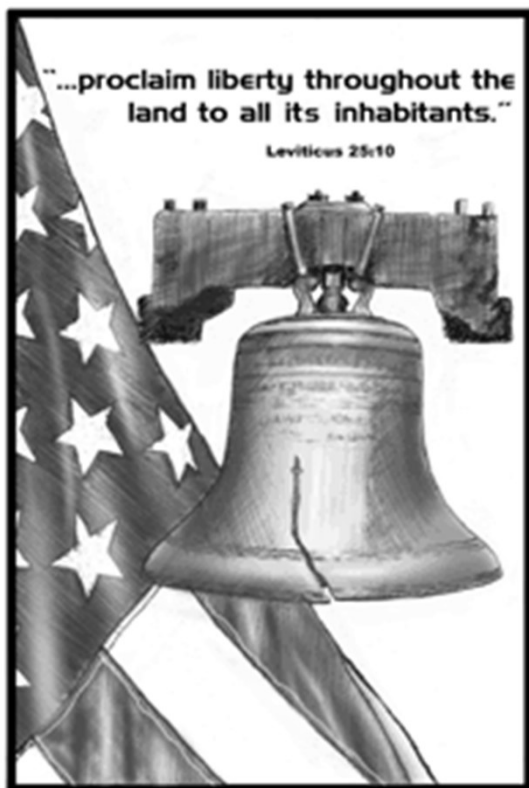
