

MISSION HIGHLIGHT: Lincoln Christian University

"Lincoln Bible Institute, 'LBI' was born in the mind and heart of Earl C. Hargrove in 1944 as the result of a God-given vision. From the very beginning unto this very day, countless people have sacrificially provided the resources to carry out this God-given vision of supplying dedicated and well-trained workers for the Kingdom." The mission statement is "to nurture and equip Christian leaders with a biblical worldview to serve and lead in the church and the world".

Lincoln Christian University (initially Lincoln Bible Institute, then Lincoln Christian College and Seminary, now Lincoln Christian University) was launched on May 4, 1944, to help prepare people to carry out God's effort through the church. For decades, LCU has trained servant leaders to serve the church and world. Mr. Hargrove, LCU's founding president, stated: "We need Kingdom workers." In addition to supplying churches with preachers, LCU has trained worship ministers, youth ministers, church secretaries, Christian education directors, small group leaders, elders, Sunday school teachers, mission committee members and a host of other roles in the church. We are thrilled that God has used so many who took classes at LCU to help build His Church.



The Covid virus has impacted the financial situation of LCU in a very dramatic way. Students were being taught virtually and the enrollment declined. On February 22, 2022, President Silas McCormick and Board Chair Tamsen Murray, announced a bold initiative to create a new model for Christian higher education which is responsive to a new era of Kingdom work.



"The new model captured in "LCU to You" seeks to fulfill the same purpose that was stated in the original Purpose and Policy drafted in 1944 and the current mission statement that has guided us

since 2006. In spite of all that has changed over the last 78 years and will be changing in coming years, LCU is still committed to playing our part in fulfilling God's purpose of making disciples of all the nations and the generations until Jesus comes.

We believe that our historic mission matters and that Lincoln alumni are still making a difference. In fact, our world desperately needs Lincoln Leaders more than ever, so we are unashamedly asking you to partner with LCU as we seek to continue fulfilling our purpose. The impact you make is significant as your gift will help equip our campus for the future and will subsidize the total educational cost of deserving students."

"The purpose of tithing is to teach you always to put God first in your lives" (Deuteronomy 14:23).

Whatever you want God to bless, you have to put him first in. So if you want God to bless your finances, you have to put him first in your money. This is the principle of tithing: You give the first 10 percent of your income back to God.

Here are four verses that explain the promise, the purpose, the place, and the day for tithing. First, Prov 3:9-10 gives the promise about tithing: "Honor the Lord by giving him the first part of all your income, and he will fill your barns with wheat and barley and overflow your wine vats with the finest wines". God says that if you honor him with the first part of your income, he will bless you financially.

Why does God tell us to tithe? Deuteronomy 14:23 says, "The purpose of tithing is to teach you always to put God first in your lives" (TLB). God doesn't need your money, but he wants what it represents: your heart. He wants you to trust him.

Where should you tithe? Do you tithe to United Way? Or do you tithe to your brother who's been out of work for three years? No. That's charity. Tithing is an act of worship. It goes to God.

Malachi 3:10 says, "'Bring to the storehouse a full tenth of what you earn . . . Test me in this,' says the Lord All-Powerful. 'I will open the windows of heaven for you and pour out all the blessings you need'" The storehouse is the temple or the place where you worship God.

When are you supposed to tithe? You do it on the day you worship. The Bible says in 1 Corinthians 16:2, "On every Lord's Day each of you should put aside something from what you have earned during the week, and use it for this offering. The amount depends on how much the Lord has helped you earn". When you give to God on the first day of the week, the first part of your day, and the first part of your money, you're declaring, "You're really number one in my life."

Notice that the verse says to "put aside." You've got to plan this! Tithing should not be an impulsive thing. You've got to plan for it so that you are honoring God's plan and purpose for tithing. Then you can watch how God blesses and uses you and honors his promise in your life. ~Rick Warren


