This was a recent discussion in our house before one of the kids went to the dentist and I was horrified that they didn't think it necessary to brush teeth before going and even thought nothing of eating a sandwich on the way! Apparently this is what we pay the dentist for – to clean our teeth!

These are silly questions but how often do we treat our relationship with God the same way: we feel the need to clean ourselves up before we come to God. We know we need Him, we know our sins and shortcomings, and we feel like we need to get those things worked out before we come to Him.

Isaiah 1:18 says, "Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool."

God is saying He wants us to come to Him just as we are, with all of our ugliness and failures and He will exchange them for a brand new second chance (or 3rd or 4th...)

The Bible also says in Isaiah 55:3: "Give ear and come to me; listen, that you may live. I will make an everlasting covenant with you, my faithful love promised to David."
