"Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain." 1 Cor. 15:58 Church Family,

So my wife called and let me know she was coming home for dinner. When she came in later than I expected, she explained that one of the main roads she drives home on every day was closed and she had to find an alternative route. If that has happened to you, you know that's frustrating.

Last week my wife and I rode our bicycles to our favorite Mexican restaurant and as we pulled into the parking lot, it was empty. We made our way to the door and it was locked and we could not go in. We realized it was Monday and they're not open on Monday. It was frustrating to arrive at the door we wished was open, but it was closed.

Have you ever had to find an alternative route? Have you ever been denied access?

I have two more questions for you: Should an alternative route ever be taken? Should access ever be denied?

OK, another question. Who gets access to your heart?

Hopefully, you know that God wants to be in your life. He wants to guide and direct us through his Holy Spirit within us. Jesus went to the cross that we might gain that privilege. So who gets access to your heart?

Is there information that should come to a dead end? Is there information that should come to a closed door?

I must confess that too often when I sit down in front of a TV or pick up my phone to gain access to information, I don't post a sign that says you must find an alternative route, or this door is closed. Even though, I am convinced that most of what Hollywood has to offer, and what many of the most popular Influencers put in front of me does not have my best interest in min

Influencers put in front of me does not have my best interest in mind. In fact often it is the exact opposite of what God would want me to consume. It certainly does not help me draw close to my Savior. It can even drive me away.

A challenge for me, that I invite you to join me in, is to frustrate the devil. If he has a commonly used path into your heart, turn him around, frustrated in the other direction. If he finds an open door to your heart, close it. Lock it. Send him away frustrated.

I believe God loves me, knows me, and knows what is best for me. I always do well to seek first his kingdom and his righteousness everywhere I go. I need to make time and give access intentionally to Him. And I need to deny access to the enemy who wants to kill steal and destroy my friendship with God.

So the next time that you or I come to a dead end or a locked door, let it be a reminder to us to filter who has access to our heart.

MISSION HIGHLIGHT: I.D.E.S.



IDES stands for International Disaster Emergency Service. IDES exists to bring glory to God by meeting physical and spiritual needs in our hurting world until Jesus returns. For the past 50 years IDES has served as a channel through which Christian Churches/Churches of Christ and individual Christians could meet the physical and spiritual needs of suffering people throughout the world. The vision statement: "IDES vision is to lead the independent Christian Churches/Churches of Christ in responding to disasters and emergencies in the United States and throughout the world by mobilizing financial and physical resources to and through their missionaries and congregations for the purpose of benevolent evangelism."

IDES has been the one source our churches and missionaries consistently turn to for help meeting physical and spiritual needs of suffering people throughout the world in the name of Jesus Christ. They have distributed millions of dollars over the years to help with disaster relief, development projects, medical needs, evangelism and hunger. Among independent Christian Churches/Churches of Christ, the work of IDES is unique.

"2023 IDES is celebrating 50 years of service. Their goal this year is to raise \$750,000 in 2023 to make sure 50 churches can be planted globally as IDES celebrates 50 years of work in the US and around the world. Each church can be started for between ten and twenty thousand dollars depending on location. We will work with our global partners to establish churches as early as late 2023." (Annual Report 2022)

In 2022 IDES was active in 49 countries with 160 projects, 117 partners and they helped over 500,000 people. There were over 8.5 K volunteer hours and over 221,000 refugees helped. Countries which received assistance were Ethiopia, Haiti, Ukraine, Honduras, Zimbabwe, Kenya as well as the United States. Whenever there is an emergency either man made or by Mother Nature IDES is "the boots on the ground" providing aid and spreading the Gospel message.

Saturday, September 9th, Countryside will be partnering with Erie Christian Church doing a GAP food bag packing event at CCC. We will be starting at 9:00 A.M. Many volunteers will be needed to fill about 15,000 bags which will be sent around the world to feed the hungry in disaster areas. The money donated at the August Cruise-in will go to IDES to cover the cost of the ingredients in the food bags.

As you can see IDES is a very busy, global organization meeting a variety of physical and spiritual needs. For more information about their activities check the mission booklet on the mission table in the foyer.


