## MISSION HIGHLIGHT: Lincoln Christian University

"Lincoln Bible Institute, 'LBI' was born in the mind and heart of Earl C. Hargrove in 1944 as the result of a God-given vision. From the very beginning unto this very day, countless people have sacrificially provided the resources to carry out this God-given vision of supplying dedicated and well-trained workers for the Kingdom." The mission statement is "to nurture and equip Christian leaders with a biblical worldview to serve and lead in the church and the world".

Lincoln Christian University (initially Lincoln Bible Institute, then Lincoln Christian College and Seminary, now Lincoln Christian University) was launched on May 4, 1944, to help prepare people to carry out God's effort through the church. For decades, LCU has trained servant leaders to serve the church and world. Mr. Hargrove, LCU's founding president, stated: "We need Kingdom workers." In addition to supplying churches with preachers, LCU has trained worship ministers, youth ministers, church secretaries, Christian education directors, small group leaders, elders, Sunday school teachers, mission committee members and a host of other roles in the church. We are thrilled that God has used so many who took classes at LCU to help build His Church.



"This fall we are bringing the classroom to the congregation via Lincoln Christian Institute in three different states. Check out a complete list of where you can find us and what we will be exploring here. And this is just the beginning. September in Columbus and Angola, IN, October St. Joe, IN and Springfield, Watseka, Dix, Lincoln and Olney, IL" (Newsletter August 2023)

"The new model captured in "LCU to You" seeks to fulfill the same purpose that was stated in the original Purpose and Policy drafted in 1944 and the current mission statement that has guided us since 2006. In spite of all that has changed over the last 78 years and will be changing in coming years, LCU is still committed to playing our part in fulfilling God's purpose of making disciples of all the nations and the generations until Jesus comes.

We believe that our historic mission matters and that Lincoln alumni are still making a difference. In fact, our world desperately needs Lincoln Leaders more than ever, so we are unashamedly asking you to partner with LCU as we seek to continue fulfilling our purpose. The impact you make is significant as your gift will help equip our campus for the future and will subsidize the total educational cost of deserving students." (Newsletter 2022)

## GAP FOOD PACKING




God Always Provides (GAP) is an opportunity for people of ALL ages to serve together and pack nutritious meals for those who are suffering from malnutrition and hunger around the world. The set up and unloading of the truck will occur at 7:30 A.M. Then, we will begin filling the bags and work until finished filling the bags (4-5 hours). During the set-up we will need approximately 10 people who can lift boxes, move tables and take directions for set up and for being a crew leader. Each crew of 10 will need a leader who can give the crew instructions and oversee their line in bag filling. We are hoping to have six crews, three from Erie, and three from CCC. Thirty-five people from CCC will be needed to be crew members and will require extended periods of standing. We plan to be finished by 11:30am - that will be determined by the number of workers. Snacks and water will be provided. A sign up list is in the church lobby. Even if you can only work for a short period of time, sign up as workers will need rest periods.

IDES provides nutritious meals which are sent to countries that have experienced disasters. Each bag contains the equivalent of 6 meals which can be reconstituted with water. Each meal contains vitamins, minerals and rice. In Sept. of 2018 we prepared 4000 bags or 24000 meals. If you have any questions please see Connie Curry.
