Each week we run near capacity and have had record attendance for these programs. The average attendance so far is between 77 and 80. This is almost double last year's. This all started with a fantastic kick off event with around 150 people on our church campus. Shortly after starting Kids Club, the Ladies Connect Conference took place with the launch of a great new ministry. Our church attendance is moving upward, and when you add up all of our church programming, I estimate that we have nearly 200 people now actively coming through our church doors on a regular basis.

In the past three weeks, I have sat down and talked with more than 20 people about placing their membership with Countryside and will have the pleasure of baptizing at least four of them in the near future. This is an exciting time for Countryside, so church family, we must humble ourselves and pray.

Let's pray together that the enemy will be bound. Let's pray together, that we will have strength to fortify our own personal commitment to Christ. Let's pray together that our church will be one, and find meaningful service and ministry to the community. Pray and ask God to reveal to you specific ways that you can advance and serve the kingdom of our Lord Jesus Christ. We can rejoice and pray together.

VETERANS DAY


HONORING ALL WHO SERVED



MISSION HIGHLIGHT: Pioneer Bible Translators

Norm and Jill Weatherhead work with Pioneer Bible Translators in Papua, New Guinea as Bible translators. They have been involved there for over 20+ years. They are from Calgary, Canada. Drawn by a vision to see God's work changing lives in every language, Norm and his wife, Jill have devoted their lives to translation work.

Late this summer Norm and Jill moved into Dallas and became "Dorm Parents" for the 30+ students who are living in the guesthouse and are attending the linguistic school on campus, Dallas International University (DIU). "We are so encouraged by seeing the enthusiasm and desire of these young people to learn the fundamental studies of Applied Linguistics, Sociolinguistics, Ethno-Arts and Musicology, Cross-Cultural Studies, and much more. Many of these students are desiring to go to other countries of the world to impact the people there with the Gospel". (Newsletter Sept. 23)

"The full Akukem national team (5 men and 1 woman) was able to come out from their remote villages to the town of Madang where our PBT office is located in PNG. Our translation team is now starting to work within the epistles of the New Testament. Our focus right now is the Pastoral Epistles (1&2 Timothy and Titus). In just 3 ½ weeks, we were able to go completely through 1 & 2 timothy. Our checking session was just ½ a day each day since my 5pm-10pm was their 8am to 1pm over in Madang."

Travel update Jill just left Dallas (Oct. 12) to go back to Calgary so she can participate in the New West Orchestra and Singers for one more season and also to host a women's retreat in Pine Lake, AB. Jill is broadening her ministry to touch the lives of women. I (Norm) will return to Calgary for two weeks (Oct.27-Nov.14) as I have travel medical insurance that allows me to travel for 75 days at a time. Jill will return to be with me and the students in the Guesthouse later in December through January." (Newsletter Oct. 23)

Praises:

- That the Akukem team members were able to travel into and out of Madang as planned to do the online Zoom checking session.
- We were able to completely review and revise 1&2 Timothy
- 2 new solar panel and laptop systems were purchased to replace old equipment so translation can keep moving forward while they are in their villages
- No one was hurt physically during the two major earthquakes that hit the Madang area just before they left to go back to the villages.

Prayer requests:

- That the translated portions of Scripture will impact the hearts of the translation team members as they work on their translation assignments.
- That we will be able to lay the foundation for printed and audio forms of Scripture which we will be able to get out to people and churches in the next year and beyond.
- That I will learn much from the Paratext courses to help our team improve our methods of Scripture translation and distribution.
