MISSION HIGHLIGHT: Me and My House

Josh and Susan Sanchez are missionaries who established the church in Manzanillo, Mexico and are now working with the church in Colima, Mexico. They have worked in Mexico since January of 2006. Josh grew up in Mexico City, Mexico and attended Central Christian College in Moberly, MO 1999-2003. Susan grew up in Mexico, MO in the Christian Church. She attended CCCB in 1999-2003 also.

This past year the Sanchezes have moved from Manzanillo to Colima to establish a new church. The year has presented many challenges in moving as well as getting established in a new area and starting a new church. They have also taken in teenagers, Rafa and Scalett who previously lived in Manzanillo.

Josh returned home November 11th after eight weeks in the United States. "We are so glad to be together as a family." Josh visited Countryside on Oct. 15th.





"The purpose of this trip was (1) a rest break in routine since Josh hasn't taken a break from ministry or been stateside in 5 years, (2) gaining new monthly supporters to replace those we have lost in death or financial hardships, and help the hurt of the failing peso exchange rate (3) update current monthly supporters by physically visiting as many as possible (4) aggressively pay down car debt (5) raise funds to build a room for a single Mom's small business, (6) re-connect with good friends and family (7) purchase clothes and shoes for our children whose sizes cannot be found in MX (example, Isaac wears men's 14 shoes, and the biggest here is 12, 36x34 jeans and the tallest here is 32.")

Financially: one supporting church has committed a generous raise for 2024, a possible raise from another, a positive maybe for a new church supporting us, and 3 couples committing to support us monthly." (newsletter Oct. 23)

Sanctity of human life




On January 13, 1984, President Ronald Reagan issued a proclamation designating January 22 as the first National Sanctity of Human Life Day. (January 22, 1973, was the day the U.S. Supreme Court legalized abortion-on-demand in all 50 states.)

The Sanctity of Life means all life is sacred and belongs to God. Nobody should take that away. From the first moments of his or her existence, a human being must be recognized as having the rights of a person – among which is the inviolable right of every innocent being to life.

Thank you so much to those who volunteered to help keep our church building clean this year! This would not happen without everyone's help! We divide the church into three sections so that it isn't overwhelming and you only need to serve twice during the year. On the following pages are the responsibilities for each area. Thank you again!

Thank you for being on the cleaning team this year!! Keeping the building clean and orderly and the restrooms well supplied with paper towels and other necessities is a very important ministry. Visitors get a first impression of our church when they experience our facilities. Clean and properly maintained facilities indicate that we care. Your efforts, in this rather mundane task of cleaning the building, are crucial to Countryside's efforts to evangelize our community. Thank you for caring and thank you for your commitment!!

In order to make things easy for everyone, the church is split into three separate areas. Your responsibility is to clean **prior to each Sunday** of the week. It should only take about an hour for your team to clean one of the areas each week.

Area A (if your name is listed first for the month) SANCTUARY, INNER AND OUTER FOYERS, OFFICE

Weekly: vacuum floors, straighten material in book racks, pick up old bulletins and paper, empty waste-baskets (don't forget baptism changing room area)

Once during the month: vacuum the pews, dust the furniture, use vacuum crevice tool at floor to wall edges, steps, etc.

As needed: straighten up furniture, replace defective light bulbs (or tell Roger Curry or Galvin Garcia), clean glass in doors, repeat monthly chores.

Area B (if your name is listed second for the month) CLASSROOMS, HALLWAY, RESTROOMS IN CLASSROOM & NEAR SANCTUARY

Weekly: vacuum floors, straighten up furniture, clean toilet stools and sinks, check paper towels, soap, and toilet paper supply, including an extra roll on the back of each stool, clean mirrors, empty waste baskets and diaper pail in nursery, clean drinking fountain

Once during the month: use vacuum crevice tool at floor to wall edges, wet mop restroom floors, dust furniture

As needed: wash chalk boards, wash table tops, replace defective light bulbs (or tell Roger Curry or Galvin Garcia), repeat monthly chores

Area C (if your name is listed third for the month) KITCHEN, GYM, LOWER FOYER & HALL, LOWER RESTROOMS, LIBRARY

Weekly: dry mop hard surface areas, vacuum carpeted areas, clean toilet stools and sinks, check paper towels, soap, and toilet paper supply, including an extra roll on the back of each stool, clean mirrors, empty waste baskets, clean kitchen sinks and counters, clean drinking fountain

Once during the month: wet mop kitchen and restroom floors, wipe down stoves, microwaves, refrigerator and freezer

As needed: clean glass in doors, repeat monthly chores, wet mop spills from gym floor, replace defective light bulbs (or tell Roger Curry or Galvin Garcia)

Place all waste material in tied plastic bags and then place in plastic bin located inside the air conditioner fence. List any cleaning supplies that are running low on the pad located just inside the janitor room door. Please tell Gabe Garcia about anything that needs to be repaired.

"The purpose of tithing is to teach you always to put God first in your lives" (Deuteronomy 14:23). Whatever you want God to bless, you have to put him first in. So if you want God to bless your finances, you have to put him first in your money. This is the principle of tithing: You give the first 10 percent of your income back to God.

Here are four verses that explain the **promise, the purpose, the place, and the day for tithing**. First, Prov 3:9-10 gives the promise about tithing: "Honor the Lord by giving him the first part of all your income, and he will fill your barns with wheat and barley and overflow your wine vats with the finest wines". God says that if you honor him with the first part of your income, he will bless you financially.

Why does God tell us to tithe? Deuteronomy 14:23 says, "The purpose of tithing is to teach you always to put God first in your lives" (TLB). God doesn't need your money, but he wants what it represents: your heart. He wants you to trust him.

Where should you tithe? Do you tithe to United Way? Or do you tithe to your brother who's been out of work for three years? No. That's charity. Tithing is an act of worship. It goes to God. Malachi 3:10 says, "Bring to the storehouse a full tenth of what you earn . . . Test me in this,' says the Lord All-Powerful. 'I will open the windows of heaven for you and pour out all the blessings you need" The storehouse is the temple or the place where you worship God.

When are you supposed to tithe? You do it on the day you worship. The Bible says in 1 Corinthians 16:2, "On every Lord's Day each of you should put aside something from what you have earned during the week, and use it for this offering. The amount depends on how much the Lord has helped you earn". When you give to God on the first day of the week, the first part of your day, and the first part of your money, you're declaring, "You're really number one in my life."

Notice that the verse says to "put aside." You've got to plan this! Tithing should not be an impulsive thing. You've got to plan for it so that you are honoring God's plan and purpose for tithing. Then you can watch how God blesses and uses you and honors his promise in your life. "Rick Warren
