MISSION HIGHLIGHT: Pioneer Bible Translators





Norm and Jill Weatherhead work with Pioneer Bible Translators in Papua New Guinea as Bible translators. They have been involved there for over 20+ years. They are from Calgary, Canada. Drawn by a vision to see God's work changing lives in every language, Norm and his wife, Jill have devoted their lives to translation work.

May 16, 2024 newsletter "Jill and I have just returned from Papua New Guinea a few days ago. What a fantastic trip it was as we worked with the Akukem team to do both Bible translation exegetical checking and to our first attempt at audio recordings of their translated book of Luke. We praise God for being able to meet and even exceed some of the goals we had set for this trip.

The primary translation goal was to clean up a few verses in 1&2 Timothy from last year's work sessions, and then to do the complete exegetical check on the book of Titus. We were able to accomplish all this in just over one week of intense checking with the Akukem translators. This allowed us to move towards a new focus of doing Scripture audio recordings.

Jill and I experienced extreme heat and humidity, often compounded by long periods of power outages that occurred almost daily. (Most outages were about 2 hours, one day it lasted about 6 hours). We had a fridge that froze everything, both up and down, at least when we had electricity. We experienced torrential rains that would flood the streets and threatened to spill into our PBT office. But no matter what we experienced, we knew that being there with the Akukem team was worth it all as we seek to bring God's word to them in their language. "

Prayer requests: That the translated portions of Scripture will impact the hearts of the translation team members as they work on their translation assignments. That we will be able to lay the foundation for printed and audio forms of Scripture which we will be able to get out to people and churches in the next year and beyond. That Norm will learn much from the Paratext courses to help our team improve our methods of Scripture translation and distribution.

Norm and Jill state that they are so grateful for our partnership with them in prayer and financial support. For more information refer to the booklet on the mission table in the foyer.


