



Let's kick off Fall with Sunday School this month! We are offering some new classes for all ages:

- 0-3 year olds The Nursery is offered for babies and toddlers during Sunday school so that parents can learn and enjoy some fellowship and peace and quiet!

- Adult Class 3 Steve Allison is heading up a class based on curriculum from Dr. Frank Turek with a focus on understanding the right and wrong in our culture.


So there you have it! Come and experience the growth and understanding that a small group study can give. And most importantly, Jesus!

MISSION HIGHLIGHT: IDES

International Disaster Emergency Service responds to emergencies around the globe through Christian churches/ Churches of Christ. IDES is located in Noblesville, Indiana. "For 50 years IDES has been known for the help and hope we provide in the name of Jesus Christ. As we look ahead at our fifty-first year and beyond, God continues to lead us, and open opportunities for the Gospel to be shared through Disaster Response, Hunger Relief, Medical Care. Community development, and Disciple Making.

Just this year IDES has responded to tornadoes, hurricanes, wildfires and floods in the United States as well as, typhoons, droughts, wars, coups, floods, fires, and earthquakes internationally. We have seen homes rebuilt, clean water wells drilled, medical needs met, food provided to the starving, and lives changed for eternity!

You can make a difference to those who are hurting by making sure resources are available and ready to be deployed immediately when a need arises. The Global Impact Fund (GIF) is the lifeblood of IDES. There' no greater way to impact the work we do than by donating to the Global Impact Fund. 


