MISSION HIGHLIGHT: IDES



International Disaster Emergency Service responds to emergencies around the globe through Christian churches/ Churches of Christ. IDES is located in Noblesville, Indiana. "For 50+ years IDES has been known for the help and hope we provide in the name of Jesus Christ. As we look ahead at our fifty-first year and beyond, God continues to lead us, and open opportunities for the Gospel to be shared through Disaster Response, Hunger Relief, Medical Care, Community development, and Disciple Making."

Last year IDES responded to tornadoes, hurricanes, wildfires and floods in the United States as well as, typhoons, droughts, wars, coups, floods, fires, and earthquakes internationally. We have seen homes rebuilt, clean water wells drilled, medical needs met, food provided to the starving, and lives changed for eternity!

"On Friday, March 28th a 7.7 magnitude earthquake struck Myanmar, devastating many communities in war-torn Myanmar and also causing damage in neighboring Thailand and our long-standing partners immediately started providing relief. Fortunately, our partners are all safe, but the death toll has risen to over 3000 people, and that number is expected to continue climbing. Widespread destruction to buildings and homes has impacted millions of people, leaving many homeless and jobless. Currently IDES is working through 7 different partners in Myanmar and Thailand to provide Help and Hope to people in need. Most of our efforts are focused on providing basic necessities, but we are also working to repair essential buildings for 2 or our partners." (Newsletters April 10, 2025)

You can make a difference to those who are hurting by making sure resources are available and ready to be deployed immediately when a need arises. The Global Impact Fund (GIF) is the lifeblood of IDES. There is no greater way to impact the work we do than by donating to the Global Impact Fund. Disasters strike often without warning, creating huge needs that are immediate and time-sensitive with no time for fundraising.

On August 17,2024 Countryside had a cruise in to raise funds for IDES. Money raised from that event will be used to purchase items for the food bags to be put together on August 16, 2025. \$3000.00 from CCC will be needed to finance that food bag packing event. On August 16, 2025, Countryside along with the Erie Christian church is having a food bag packing event here at Countryside Christian Church. Final plans and sign-ups will happen in early August. BLOOD DRIVE UPDATE

On April 12, a blood drive was held at Countryside for Impact Life. We collected 23 units of blood plus one unit of plasma. Our goal was 16 so we surpassed that by a long ways. Our next blood drive will be Nov. 15 with the last donation date of September 20 to be eligible for donating in November.

A big THANK YOU to all who donated on Saturday. Those 23 units of blood have been a blessing to many individuals in need.


